BALANCING

When the opponents open the bidding and reach a partscore contract, it is tempting to feel the auction is over. In fact, it might be a relief that the opponents have not bid game.

This isn't the time to sit back!

Your partnership might have as much strength as the opponents and you could also have a suitable trump fit.

You should readily compete in these auctions...

BEST USE OF CUEBIDS

Why would we want to bid the same suit that the opponents have bid! There are at least five good reasons. This workshop will put you at ease through understanding the rationale behind the use of the cuebid. It's a good way to communicate with partner.

The key to success is to consider your position in the auction:

- When overcalling, the cuebid is a good way to show two suits with one bid!
- When responding to an opening suit bid, the cuebid can be used to show support for partner's suit.
- When advancing partner's overcall, the cuebid can keep you from getting too high.
- When responding to 1NT, the cuebid can be used as a substitute for Stayman.
- When advancing a takeout double, the cuebid can be a valuable tool for getting the partnership to its best trump fit.

In the modern game, cuebids have assigned meanings — not to be confused with control-showing bids. The workshop will make the difference clear.

When you don't know what to do...cue!!!

This workshop will put you in an excellent position to do just that.
