This tour allows you a more extensive look at the magnificent, multileveled, famous Mayan ruin best known for its Temple of the Masks.

Begin your excursion at the pier and travel with your guide to the Kohunlich ruins. Along the way, you will learn about the site and the history of this fascinating area. Upon arrival, you will embark on a guided exploration through this breathtaking site that is named after the majestic cahoon palm tree that grows fronds up to 40-ft. tall. The park-like setting includes a sunken palace, acropolis, ball court and courtyards but the main attraction is the masks!

Take the opportunity to climb the pyramid-like temple to get a great view of the unique 10-ft. high sculpted masks of the Sun God "Kinich Ahau" that run up each side of the stairways. Built before 500 A.D., these marvelous masks still retain some of their original colored stucco. Kohunlich's broad range of architecture, natural beauty and expansive, uncrowned seclusion set it apart from the more widely toured sites.

After a visit of approximately 2 1/2 hours, you will rejoin your coach and make your way to the Lagoon Club for a tasty lunch of regional favorites before returning to the pier.

Please note: This tour includes a considerable amount of walking over uneven and rough surfaces. Care should be taken as the surfaces can be slippery. The tour is not available to wheelchair guests and not considered suitable for those with mobility concerns. Flat, comfortable, closed-toe walking shoes; sun caps; sunglasses; sunscreen and insect repellent are suggested. There is a government tax of \$5-8 USD on the use of video cameras at the site. This snorkeling adventure is the perfect tour for the beginner and intermediate snorkeler as you snorkel safely from the beach and progress only as you feel comfortable with your guide.

It's a scenic 50-minute drive from the pier to one of the newest destinations on the coast that was once reserved for the most ardent divers. Upon arrival at the beach, you will receive your snorkel gear and your P.A.D.I. certified dive guide will give you an in-depth briefing on how to use the gear and how to snorkel. There is also an interesting narration about the extensive infrastructure of the reef and beach.

Once you are ready, your dive guide will then help you into the water, which was designed to be easy access from the shore. The tour begins in the shallow areas where nature has provided a perfect refuge for young sea life. As you feel comfortable, you will then continue on to the nearby reefs to explore the natural beauty of this amazing eco-system. The tropical marine life is plentiful and will greet you as you enter the water with such species as parrotfish, butterfly fish, angelfish and an occasional glimpse of an eagle ray. Water depths will range from 3-15 feet.

After approximately 45-minutes, your tour of this incredible underwater garden is complete and you will exit at the beach entry point. There will be time allotted to freshen up and enjoy a cold drink before it's time to re-board your transportation and transfer back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of activity and participants should be in good physical condition and be able to swim. The tour is not available to wheelchair guests, guests with mobility concerns, recent back or neck injuries, heart conditions, epilepsy, diabetes, respiratory conditions or pregnant women. Flat, comfortable walking shoes or aqua socks; swim suits; towel; a change of clothing; sun caps; sunglasses and sunscreen are suggested. Snorkel gear (vest, snorkel, mask & fins) are provided. Tour participants taking part in any water activities do so at their own risk and responsibility and will be required to sign a release form before being allowed to take part in any snorkeling activities. Minimum age to participate is 10 years of age and maximum is 70. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian. Restrooms facilities are available at the beach. Explore the ruins of Chacchoben, "The Place of Red Corn", on this half-day tour that brings you to this fascinating ancient Mayan pilgrimage location.

Starting off from the pier, it's a pleasant 50-minute drive to the site, during which your local guide will share with you the interesting history and unique culture of the Mayas. Upon arrival, you will find yourself surrounded by the lush green jungle that still hides much of the complex and is home to a wide variety of wildlife, including howler monkeys and many species of exotic birds. Here, in this lush tropical setting, the excavated sacred temples and other structures will fill you with a sense of wonder as you picture how it must have looked centuries ago when it was a thriving cultural center for the Mayans.

During your escorted tour you will have a chance to see the original red paint on the stucco walls of one of the pyramids and the temple where a mural was found showing the astronomical positions of the planet Venus. You will also have time to climb the Gran Basamento which takes you above tree level and is where archaeologists found ceremonial offerings dating to around 1000 B.C.

During your visit, your guide will also explain about the wildlife found in this region of Mexico and the medicinal plants that are still used by the modern-day descendents of the ancient Mayan people.

Before re-boarding your coach for the return transfer to the pier, you will have a brief break to enjoy a complimentary beverage and perhaps purchase a souvenir.

Please note: This tour includes a considerable amount of walking over uneven and rough surfaces. Care should be taken as the surfaces can be slippery. The tour is not available to wheelchair guests or pregnant women and is not considered suitable for those with mobility concerns. Flat, comfortable, closed-toe walking shoes; sun caps; sunglasses; sunscreen (biodegradable only) and insect repellent are suggested. Minimum age to participate is 3-years old. Those under 18-years of age are prohibited from consuming alcohol. There is a government tax of \$5-8 USD on the use of video cameras at the site. No tripods and/or professional video cameras are allowed. Flash photos are not allowed inside the ruins due to the delicate nature of the displays. No food is allowed in the ruins.

You'll soon see how simple it is to get around on your Segway. To move it forward or backward, just lean forward or backward. A similar move steers the Segway left or right. With just two wheels, the Segway stays balanced, so all you have to do is to hop on, stand upright and lean one way or the other. Once you feel comfortable operating the Segway, you'll set-off with your fellow guests to explore Costa Maya.

Then, traveling in a caravan of Segways, you'll follow a route along the beautiful coastline to the main shopping area of Costa Maya. There you'll have time to browse the boutiques, shopping for favorites such as beachwear and silver jewelry. Then, it's on to the beach club, where you're free to swim or do nothing more energetic than sip a cool drink while watching the waves break on the shore. This is your time to do as you please. Then, whenever you're ready to depart, you'll find a taxi waiting to drive you back to the pier.

Please note: Walking on this tour is mainly at the guests' discretion during the stops; however, guests must be able to stand on the Segway for approximately 2-hours. There are natural, uneven and sandy surfaces to negotiate. This tour is not available to wheelchair guests; pregnant women; those with back or knee injuries; heart conditions; asthma; epilepsy or mobility issues. Light weight clothing; swimwear; a change of clothes; towel; sun cap; sunglasses; sunscreen; and flat, comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Helmets will be provided and are mandatory. There is a minimum weight requirement of 100 lbs and the maximum allowable weight is 250 lbs. The minimum age to participate in the tour is 12 years of age and the maximum age limit is 65. All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian. Those taking part in any water activities do so at their own risk and responsibility. The operator does require that participants sign a waiver before being allowed to take part in the tour. It is suggested guests bring cash if they wish to purchase souvenirs. Transfer to the Segway location is via 4-seater taxis which may or may not have a/c.

## HAR-001 MAYAN RUINS & SPICE FARM

Discover the ancient Mayan archeological site of Nim Li Punit along with its treasures and visit the Belize Spice Farm and Botanical Gardens to see how they cultivate and harvest exotic spices.

It's a 30 minute boat transfer from Harvest Caye to the mainland of Belize where you will board your air-conditioned bus for a 1 hour scenic ride to the archeological site of Nim Li Punit, "Large Hat" in the Mayan Kekchi language. The site was so named due to a depiction on a Maya stela of one of its rulers wearing a very large head dress. This unique Mayan ceremonial site has a small museum and a welcome center where you can see some of the large stelas with well-preserved Maya drawings and writing, as well as artifacts. It also has a ball-court in the center of the complex and an observatory in one of the plazas. The entire site is shaded by a canopy of large trees, providing a comfortable environment for viewing this very interesting Mayan site.

Next, you'll head over to the Belize Spice Farm and Botanical Gardens and see how vanilla, nutmeg, maze cardamom, cinnamon, cloves and black pepper are cultivated. As you travel through the farm via tram, you'll see how these unique spices are dried and processed for packaging. On Lake Izabal, you will find the tiny Castle of San Felipe, or Castillo de San Felipe, the Spanish fort built to protect the Rio Dulce from invading pirates. You will then take a brief boat ride to the castle for an inside visit. Located just minutes from the bridge, the Castle of San Felipe was built during the 17th century in honor of the Spanish King Felipe II. The fort, with its powerful battery of cannons strategically positioned at the entrance to Lake Izabal, offered protection to Spanish ships crossing its waters, and transporting products and supplies to and from Spain and Havana. Its walls offered protection from pirates that used to navigate the river and attack the boats they encountered along the way.

In 1686, a pirate assault burned most of the fort, and the attacks continued until a series of treaties were signed between Spain and England. As a result, the Castillo lost its importance as a defensive fort, and was converted into a prison. It was later abandoned, and fell into a state of disrepair until its renovation by Architect Francisco Ferrus in 1955. Although rebuilt based upon its original plans, the Castle of San Felipe still retains two cannons dating back to the 1790s, and a pair of 400-year-old towers.

Following your tour, you will proceed to the Catamaran Hotel for refreshments before returning to the ship.

Please note: Wear long pants and a long-sleeved shirt, and bring sunscreen a hat, sunglasses and insect repellent. Guides will assist guests embarking the boats, but guests must be able to step into and out of the boat on their own; a challenging feat during low tide.

The Tower of the Shaman at the top of the hill uses the ancient methods of directional construction. Utilized by the Maya for tracking sun and moon activity, it served as the basis of their baffling advancement in the areas of astronomy and calendar development.

A poolside barbecue will be served during the 1.5-hour lunch break, followed by some time to relax or swim in the pool. Time permitting, you may choose to take in one of the optional activities available for an addition charge, including horseback riding or kayaking.

Following your visit, you will re-board your boat for the return trip to the bridge, then be transferred back to the pier. Swimming pool access is not guaranteed.

Discover the Mayan way of life along the Tatin River, and the generosity of the non-profit organization that made it all possible during this memorable visit to the Q'eqchi indigenous river community.

Depart the pier aboard a 30-passenger boat (fitted for 15), and proceed for the ride towards Rio Dulce; an area of exquisite natural beauty that serves as a sanctuary to a variety of aquatic birds and wildlife. Approximate transfer time is 45 minutes. Upon arrival, you will visit Ak' Tenamit, a Maya Q'eqchi community development located on the Tatin River.

Ak' Tenamit is a non-profit organization founded in 1992 by American visionary Steve Dudenhoefer. This successful volunteer-supported operation helps with the sustained development and recuperation of the Mayan culture within the Q'eqchi villages of Rio Dulce. Ak' Tenamit provides assistance to more than 9,000 people that were displaced as a result of land reform and violence stemming from the civil war of 1963-1996. These people have been relocated to 45 villages in this area.

Ak' Tenamit conducts programs on education, crafts, health, organic agriculture, eco-tourism, community development, gender equality, and more. Its headquarters is divided between the north side of the Rio Dulce Canyon, where the first school was built and a floating dental clinic is stationed, and the Tatin River, where an ecological footpath through the forest, arts and crafts shop, a restaurant and second school has been established. Ak' Tenamit uses computer-based tutorial learning to empower rural students to be successful in their own rural setting. During your visit, you will be served a local snack and have the opportunity to purchase souvenirs made by local artisans.

Next, you will continue across the river to the opposite bank, and sail past a mangrove lagoon and water lilies for an opportunity to learn how Q'eqchi villagers live. En route, you will see the headquarters on the north side of the Rio Dulce Canyon.

Following your visit, you will proceed to Amatique Bay Resort for lunch accompanied by a performance of Garifuna music and dancing. After lunch, you will embark the boat for the return ride to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a 30-minute walk in the jungle over rough surfaces and includes some steep steps to negotiate. Embarking the small boats requires guests to be agile enough to bend and climb, and endure a bumpy boat ride. This tour will use a local boat (covered on top). After departing from the pier, you will settle in for a meandering drive through the jungle to Rio Dulce, a town named for the river there that flows from Lake Izabal. Nearby, you will stop at a plantation that grows cacao or cocoa, the main ingredient in making chocolate.

The tree's scientific name is *Theobroma cacao*; the first word being Latin for "food of the gods," the second derived from the Aztec word for "bitter water." The indigenous people of Central America have been processing and eating the tree's fruit for at least 2,000 years.

Cacao was so valued at the time that it was depicted in hieroglyphic writings and paintings, and the seeds were used as money. The resulting chocolate, which was often flavored with vanilla, herbs and honey, was reserved for royalty and the wealthy.

While touring the cacao plantation, you will learn how the fruit is picked, processed, packaged and exported. The steps are fascinating, and you will have the chance to sample the cacao during the various stages of production.

You will taste a cacao seed, a chunk of solid chocolate, a dollop of chocolate paste, and a chocolate beverage similar to the ones that the ancient Aztecs and Mayas drank. You will also learn how the taste of chocolate develops through fermentation.

They are extremely fast swimmers and use their long, spear-like upper jaw to slash through schools of fish, wounding them so they can easily be consumed. If you catch one of these strikingly beautiful billfish, be prepared for a tremendous fight, as blue marlins are powerful and have a reputation for tenacity that borders on the legendary.

If the captain opts to go after kingfish, you'll have a fight of a different sort on your hands. Kingfish, also known as King Mackerel, are aggressive, hard-hitting and built for speed. They typically feed by sight in the daytime, attacking their prey from underneath, prodigiously leaping out of the water on the follow through, and then returning to the water headfirst like a diver. Over the next hour or so, you'll drive down jungle roads and sand paths, taking in the spectacular natural beauty of the island. Chances are, you may see saltwater crocodiles lazing in the sun or lingering in the lagoon's still waters. Iguanas, flamingos and migratory birds are also commonly observed.

Upon reaching Punta Sur Park on the southernmost tip of Cozumel, you'll stop for photos at Celarain Lighthouse, which looms over the rocky shoreline. The views from the top of this whitewashed beacon are inspiring, as is its marine navigation museum. Nearby are the ruins of El Caracol, which is believed to be a lighthouse built by the Mayas 700 years ago.

Still, it's the beaches at Punta Sur Park that leave the most lasting impression. During the approximately two hours you'll spend along the shores of this 2,500-acre ecological reserve, you can snorkel, swim or simply relax. The serenity and sheer magnificence of the natural landscape are so mesmerizing that time seems to slow to a near standstill, the only interruption being the sound of the waves gently lapping the coastline. Following this tranquil respite at the beach, you'll retrace your path back to the pier.

Please note: Walking on this tour is mainly at the guests' discretion during the stops; however, there are natural, uneven and sandy surfaces to negotiate. Along the way, you and another guest will experience the excitement of flight while seated side-by-side with our new tandem bar. Your special vantage-point hundreds of feet above the Atlantic Ocean will enable you to take in panoramic views of Key West and its beachfront. Photo packages will be available to capture all of the action and excitement.

Following your tour, you will be returned to the pier, where you may opt to return to your ship or explore Key West at your leisure.

Please note: The walk from the ship to the parasailing boat is approximately 400 yards over a flat, paved surface. All guests will be required to fill out a liability waiver to participate on this tour. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or guests who utilize a wheelchair. The boat may not be exclusive to RSSC guests. The minimum age to participate is 12 years old. Weight restrictions require a minimum of 75 pounds per person, and a maximum combined weight not to exceed 600 pounds. Operation of this tour is dependent upon wind speeds, which must be well within safety guidelines. The boat is not exclusive to Regent Seven Seas guests.

See Key West from the harbor aboard a former Navy launch, which offers a wonderful perspective to view historical sites such as Fort Zachary Taylor and Mallory Square.

After boarding the boat at the pier, you will soon cruise through Key West Bight and head toward Mallory Square while the captain describes the historical points of interest. Now legendary for its sunset celebrations, Mallory Square has been a social and commercial hub since the 1820s, when ships carrying goods from shipwrecks docked there.

Before long, Fort Zachary Taylor will come into view. The fort is a National Historic Landmark that played an important role in the Civil War and Spanish-American War.

In time, the boat will turn back, affording you a closer view at the seaside residences on Sunset Key and the Coast Guard Station, which first established a presence in Key West in 1824.

You will then pass under the bridge that connects Key West to Fleming Key, which is home to a naval air station.

By the time you return to the pier, you will have a greater understanding of Key West.

Note: There are very large and easy stairs on and off the vessel as well as cushions on every seat. Half of the boat is covered with shade as well as large fans and misters to keep guests cool. There is a restroom on board.
